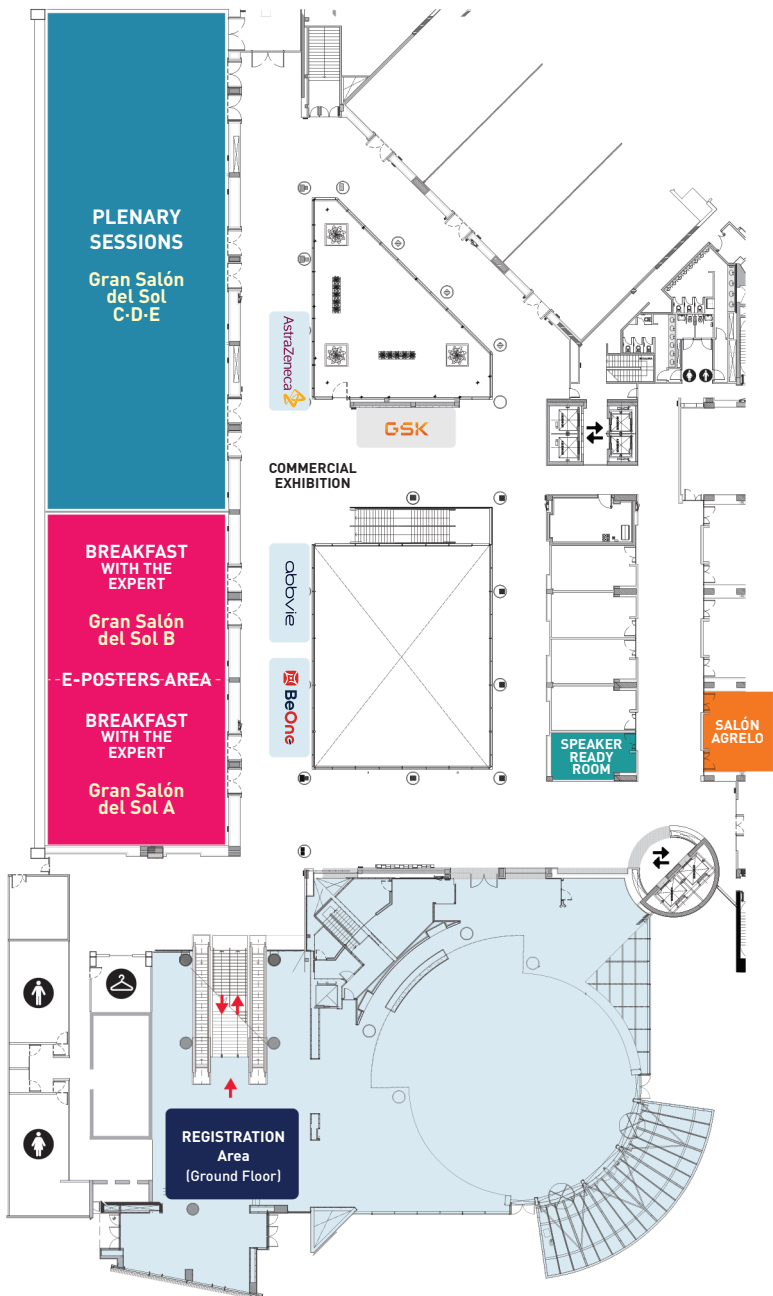

WELCOME

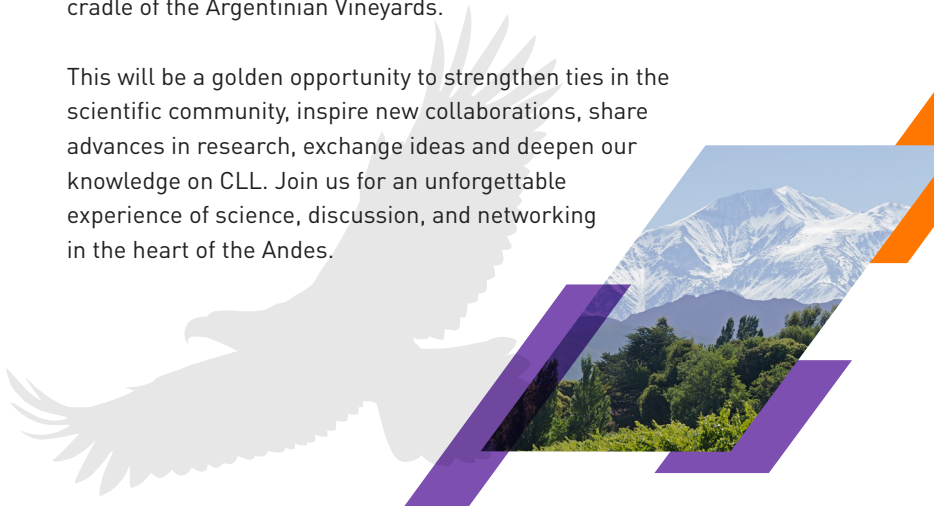

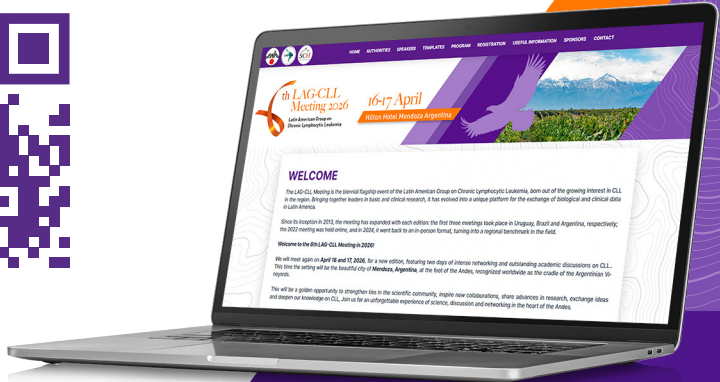
