

iwCLL Fellowships for CLL Researchers to Attend Latin American Group (LAG-CLL) Meeting 2026 in Mendoza, Argentina

To promote regional collaboration and scientific exchange, iwCLL will offer fellowships to support the participation of Latin American researchers at the LAG-CLL Meeting, which will be held in Mendoza, Argentina, on April 16–17, 2026.

About the Fellowship

Up to 20 (twenty) fellowships (USD 800 each one) will be awarded to support in-person attendance at the LAG-CLL 2026 meeting. The financial support will cover travel expenses to Mendoza, Argentina.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be preferentially scientists or healthcare professionals engaged in basic/translational research in CLL, based in Latin America.
- Be the author or co-author of an abstract submitted to the meeting.
- Not be receiving other sources of financial support to attend the event (to avoid funding overlap).
- Fellowship funds will be granted only upon abstract acceptance.

How to Apply

Applications must include:

- A brief biosketch.
- A one-page motivation letter describing how your participation in the meeting would contribute to advancing CLL research in your home country.
- A letter of support from your local mentor or supervisor (if applicable).
- **A copy of the abstract submitted** to the meeting, including all authors and affiliations.
- **APPLICATION DEADLINE: March 01, 2026, 11:59 PM (ARG time).**

Evaluation and Selection Process

- Applications will be reviewed by members of the iwCLL Executive Board.
- Evaluation will consider:
 - Scientific relevance and quality of the submitted abstract.



- Potential impact of the applicant’s participation on CLL research in their country.
 - Geographic diversity — special consideration will be given to ensure representation from a wide range of Latin American countries.
- Applications that do not meet the eligibility criteria or fall outside the scope of this opportunity will not be considered.
- **Applicants will be notified of the results on March 19, 2026.**
